GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR THE WINTER CARNIVAL

1. All matches shall be played in accordance with B. A. Laws and the following Conditions for Play. Upon entering the Carnival all participants agree to abide by these conditions and should a problem or dispute arise the Carnival committee decision shall be final.
2. As the Controlling Body, the Carnival Committee shall be in control of ALL matches, players and officials and shall have the power to enquire into and adjudicate should any dispute arise, to make, alter or add to the Condition it deems necessary, under all circumstances and its decision shall be final.
3. No entry fees will be refunded in the event of a withdrawal after the closing date. Only two (2) greens are available with 32 nominations available for each event. Refunds will be made to nominations in the events over subscribed.
4. **SCORING**
Two points shall be awarded for a win and one point for a tie. If points scores are equal the team with the largest difference between “total shots for” and “total shots against” shall be the winner. If there is still a tie, the team with the highest “total shots for” shall be the winner.
5. Play in all matches shall commence in accordance with the times set out in the format for each event and play must be continued without delay. If, in the opinion of the Games Official, everything is in readiness, then play can commence earlier than the scheduled time. **TIME LIMIT APPLIED.**

TIME TABLE

15 Ends for Pairs & 16 Ends for Fours or time limit of 2hrs 15min

6. TRIAL ENDS are NOT permitted for any matches.
7. DEAD ENDS do NOT count and shall be played anew.
8. SLOW PLAY: Players shall play their bowls without delay. Players changing ends as part of the playing of an End shall do so without delay. Players called to the head (3rd or Skip) shall do so promptly and without delay.
9. Team members not engaged as part of the head will retire to the bank.
10. Should any Player or Team wilfully waste time, the Umpire, ON APPEAL, shall warn them and if they still continue to offend, he shall award the match to the opponents.
11. FORFEITS:

A team receiving a forfeit shall be credited with a win and awarded two points and the average number of shots margin per game of the games played.

12. Where the time limit has expired and the BELL has been rung, any end in progress shall be completed. If the end becomes dead it shall not be replayed. If the Jack has been improperly rolled at the time limit the opponent of the offender shall reroll it. If both players improperly roll the Jack ONCE EACH, the procedure as set out in law 23 shall apply.
13. Wins take precedence, then draws
14. Only one cash prize can be won by any team.
15. INCLEMENT WEATHER
A game shall be constituted if more than half of the entered teams have completed more than eight (8) ends.
16. If due to INCLEMENT WEATHER and the event is abandoned a refund will be made to all players and must remain in attendance until otherwise advised.
17. SUBSTITUTES shall be permitted in all Games strictly in accordance with B. A. Law 40.
NOTE: Substitutes are not eligible if they have previously played or are playing in that particular event.
18. ATTIRE:
Competitors in all Games must be correctly attired. (B. A. Law 12).
Coloured Shirts and jackets approved by a State or national Authority for use as representatives of a Club, District, State or national Authority may be worn. All logos must be worn in accordance with the Carnival Committee requirements. Any variation from this condition without permission could incur disqualification from the event in which the offence occurs.
19. CHALLENGE TO BOWLS: In the event of a challenge to a set of bowls being lodged during the course of the Carnival (by the Skip in a team event on behalf of the team or a Singles player), the Bowls under challenge shall be subject to an official "table test" by an official bowls tester. The test shall be arranged by the DBA Secretary on behalf of the Carnival Committee as soon as practicable. Upon lodging the challenge the challenger shall deposit the sum of \$100 with the Official Umpire and in conjunction with the Umpire and the club Carnival Games Official complete and sign the "Official Challenge to Bowls" form. By doing so the challenger agrees the result of the official table test is both binding and final. The player whose bowls are under challenge, if having won the match and the table test is not completed prior to commencement of the next round game, shall proceed with another set of bowls. Should the challenged bowls fail the official table test the layer/team shall be disqualified.
20. ALL DECALS to be removed from bowls prior to commencement of play.
21. MOBILE TELEPHONES are forbidden anywhere near the greens and must remain inside the club house.
